- Nominee videos almost overlapped, need a bit of a pause.
- The stage could be set up in a more professional way.
- The master of ceremonies duties were discussed.
- The caterer was discussed.

The Committee addressed other items to consider as preparation for next year's event including:

- Marketing budget and providing more of a promotional package to potential sponsors.
- Athlete of the year nominations were lean.
- Ways to improve nominations were discussed.
- The naming of the awards and the word "Civic" may not be recognized by a segment of the community. Focus on "Community"
- Program printing – print less in the future.
- Future sponsors to approach were discussed.
- Check-in logistics were discussed.
- Budget was accurate with some additional expense on video production.
- New nominations.
- Non-monetary nominations were discussed as a criteria and if it should continue.
- Nominations and award winners by gender were discussed.
