


Route 6: Downtown/UBCO limited service




Service Considerations

- Route efficiency & legibility
- Travel patterns and priorities travel demand from Glenmore to key destinations
- Current transit demand






Route 6: Pandosy/UBCO



Public Engagement Results Transit Future Action Plan



If you had to choose one of these two options, which would you prefer?




Combined results – online & open houses




Academy Way

Option 2 Enhanced



Budget

- 5,000 service hours approved in 2018 Transit Operating Budget.
- Up to 60% of budgeted hours Glenmore/ Midtown restructuring.
- Remainder On-time performance and targeted service frequency enhancements network wide.

Recommendation



That Council approve the recommended service package; Option 2 Enhanced for implementation in September, 2018.
