What is CARIP?



- <u>Climate</u> <u>Action</u> <u>Revenue</u> <u>Incentive</u> <u>Program;</u>
- A grant equal to 100% of the carbon taxes paid directly by a municipality;
- This year applying for \$285,409;
- Grant placed in City's Ro11- Energy Management Rebate fund

To be eligible must make public and submit the CARIP Report to the Province by June 1.

2017 Community Highlights



- Climate Action, Transportation and Housing Plans under development
- Transportation network improvements:
 - ▶ 1.48 km of sidewalk
 - o.7 km of cycle track / shared paths
 - 3 km of bike lanes to buffered bike lanes
 - Transit improvements
- 500 trees sold through Neighbourwoods
- Acquired 20.4 hectares of parkland

2018 Community Actions



- Launched update of OCP to 2040
- Update Building Bylaw to reference Energy Step Code
- Develop a community energy retrofit strategy
- Implement curbside bulky item collection program
- Deploy bikeshare pilot
- Build 6.7km of Rails with Trails



2017 Corporate Highlights



- Completion of Kelowna Police Services Building
- Drafted Corporate Energy and GHG Emissions Update
- Commissioned landfill gas system
- Planted 5,000 seedlings
- Added 3 hybrids to fleet



2018 Corporate Actions



- City wide LED street light retrofit (saving 4.5 GWh/yr)
- Rutland Arena Real Ice Installation (saving 73,000kWh, 264 GJ/yr)
- Plant 250 large caliper trees
- Add 3 electric vehicles to fleet
- Investigate partnering with Dropbike for employee use





CARIP Emissions Reporting

- 2017 Corporate CARIP Emissions = 6,526 tonnes
- Emissions increased from last year due to cold winter causing
 - Increase in natural gas for heating
 - Increase in fuel for snow removal



Climate Adaptation



- New for 2018 report on actions to address changing climate
 - Updates to Bylaw 7900 to address storms and stormwater
 - Investigations to attenuate higher streamflows
 - Flood mapping
