A community willing to learn, adapt and grow so we can thrive amid rapid change.

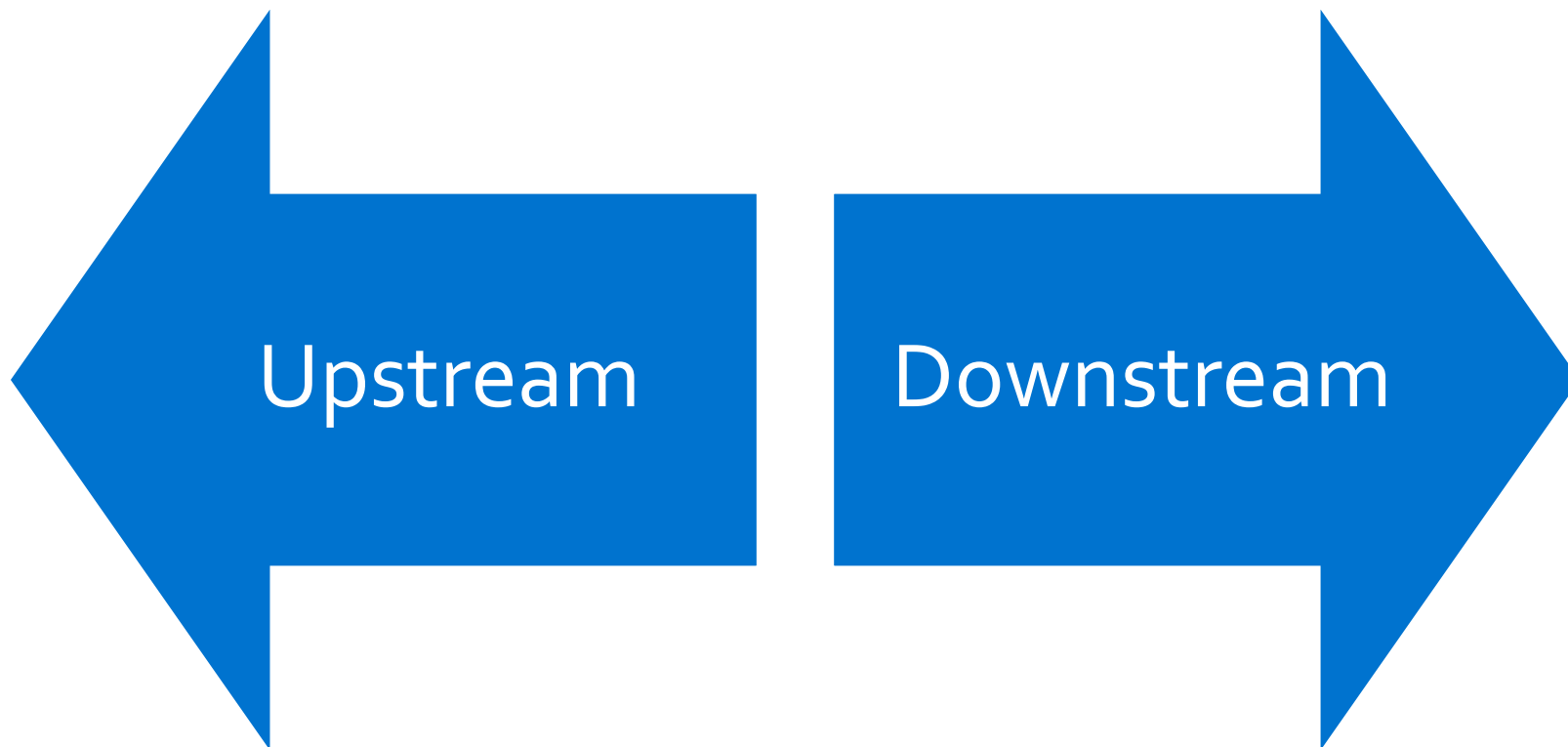
Connected

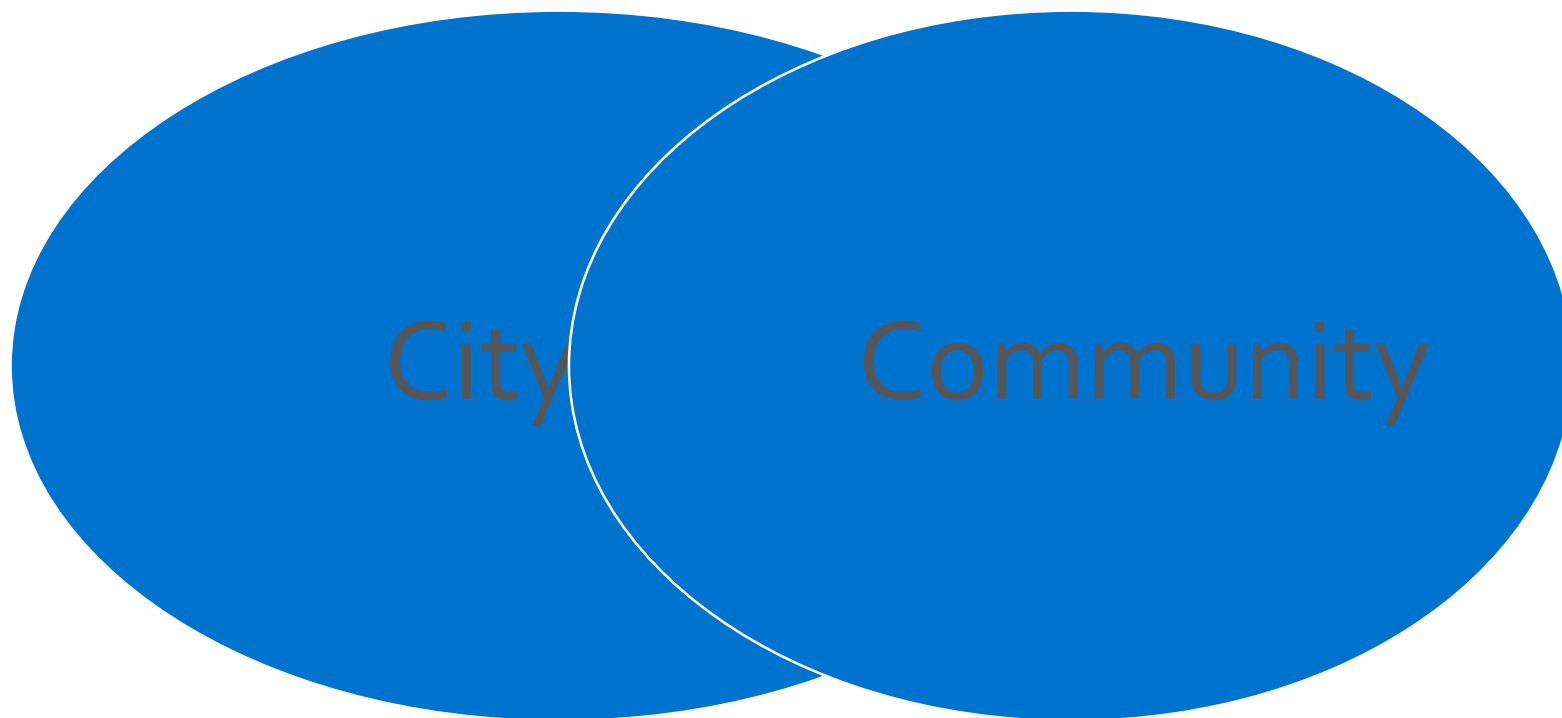
A community where residents are connected to their neighbours, their city and the wider world.
