Purpose of Bylaw 9200

- Required under the Community Charter
- Establishes general Council/Committee procedures
 - Good meeting management
 - Clarity for Council, public and staff
 - Must include things related to procedural rules and public notice





Proposed Amendments Bylaw 9200 - Legislative

Must amend - Legislative

- 2.1 Inaugural meeting date
- 5.4 (c) Tuesday Regular Meeting Council directed staff to include Oath of Office (been included in practice)

Proposed Amendments Bylaw 9200 - Review

- May amend Recommended
 - Change posting of notice
 - from bulletin board to outside of Council Chamber; include web site
 - Clarify procedures related to:
 - Public Hearing correspondence summary; 'address' to read civic, street, or jurisdiction or a combination thereof
 - Order of Proceedings review items, order and form of agenda as presented
