

Seasonal Transit Service Changes & Operations Facility Capacity

January, 2020



Purpose

TO inform Council of the Spring/Summer adjustments to transit service levels.

AND TO update Council on efforts to relieve constraints at the current transit facility.



System-Level Ridership


▶ 15% ridership growth over past two years.

30% greater productivity in the Fall/Winter period vs. Spring.

► 38% greater in the Fall/Winter period vs. summer.



Seasonal Ridership Fluctuations





Spring/Summer Service Changes

- Seasonal discontinuation of #13 Quail Ridge, #4 Pandosy-UBCO and select trips on other routes serving Post-Secondary and Secondary Schools.
- Discontinuation of underperforming trips and reductions to service frequency on select routes.
- Increased Sunday service frequency route 10 North Rutland.

September 2020



Approved 950 hour service off-peak service expansion.

- Bus blocking changes to improve efficiencies and reduce peak-bus demand.
- Focus resources on meeting demand and improving schedule reliability on routes 8 and 97.
