




Proposal




Context Map



Site Layout




HAN FLOOR EVENT SPACE AREA, 1700 SF HAN FLOOR LIGHOR SERVICE AREA, 5400 SF

► The proposal will include a café, function room and a music hall.





Council Policy#359

- ► Location is suitable
 - Within a Downtown Urban Centre.
- ► Hours of service are suitable (9 AM to 12am/1am)
 - ► Large capacity events to end one hour earlier than the termination of liquor service.
- ► The occupant load is more than 500 persons, but the venue is to operate like a theater / hotel ballroom and is not consistent with a nightclub.



Staff Recommendation

- Staff recommend support for a new Liquor Primary License;
- ► The proposal fills void in arts and culture, including a live music venue.
- ➤ That Council directs Staff to forward a resolution of support to the LCRB for the Liquor Primary License.
