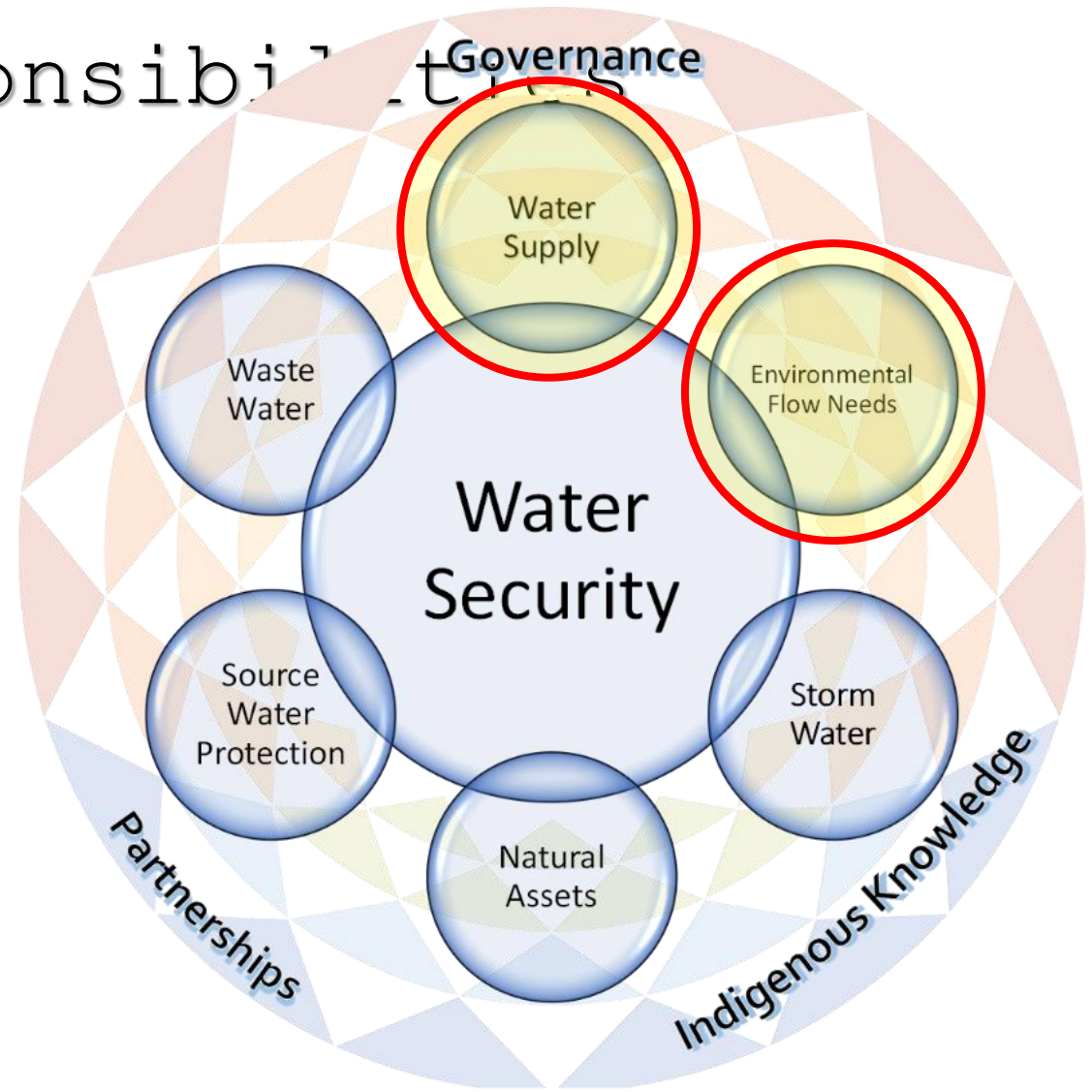


Potable & Non-Potable Water Supply Status

Presentation to Council – July 22, 2024

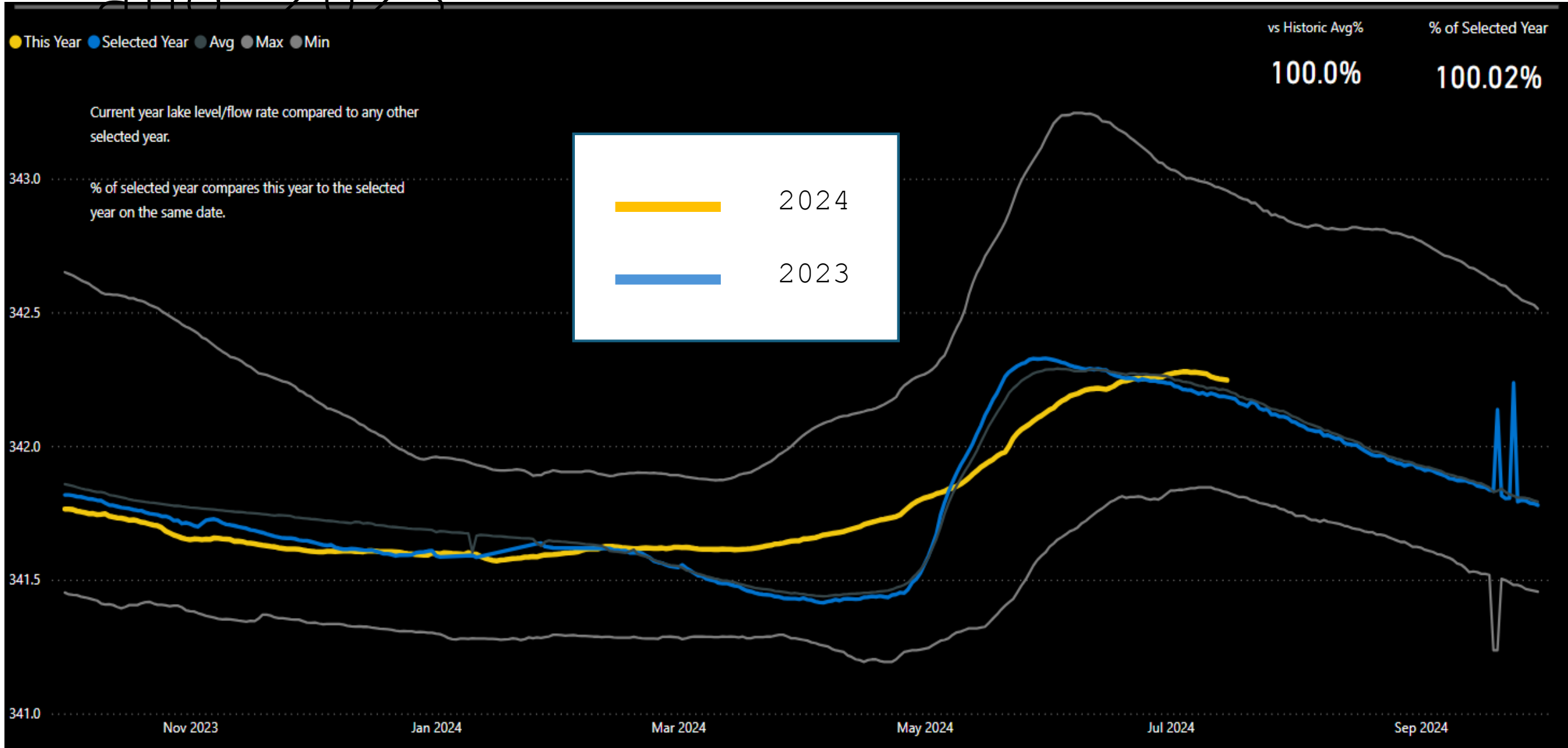
Water Security/Responsibilities

Principle 1: "All residents and water users in the City have a safe, affordable, resilient and sustainable supply of high-quality drinking water and a reliable supply of water for agriculture.
Principle 7: "Assure that the quality and quantity of water is available to support a healthy aquatic ecosystem."

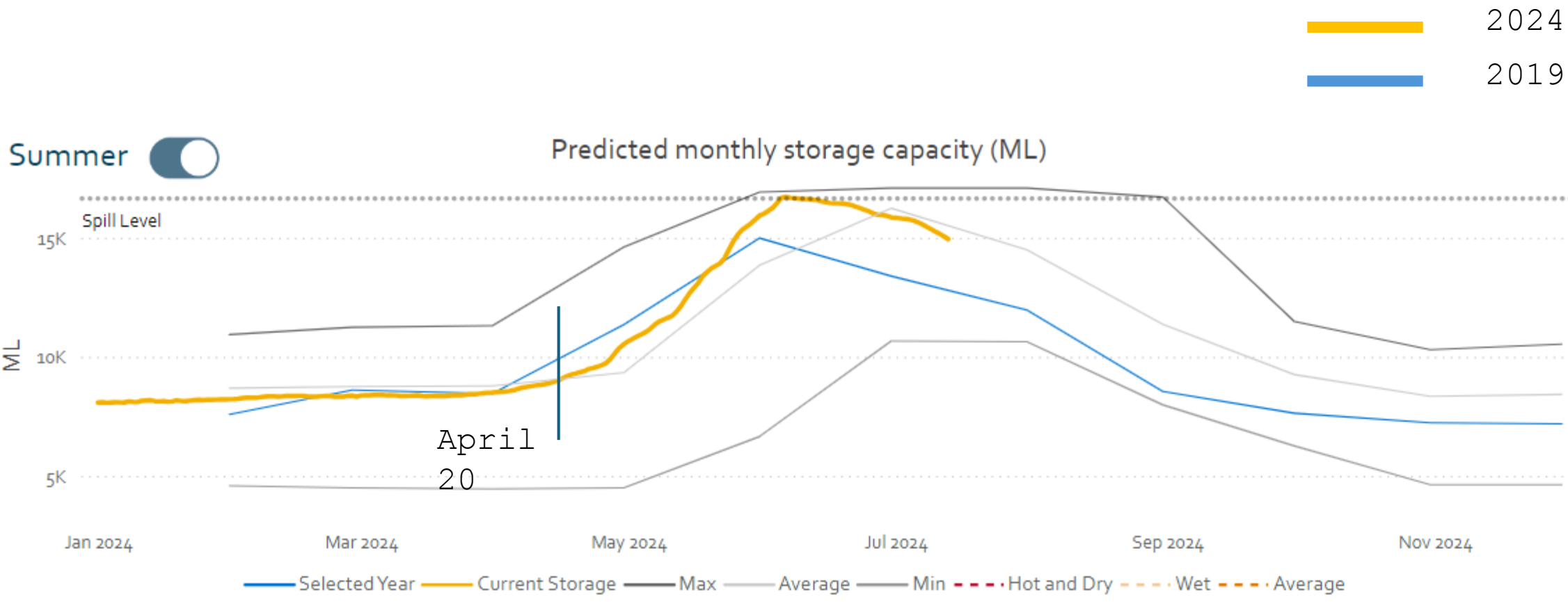


The six water sectors outlined in the City's Water Security Planning Process

Okanagan Lake Levels – Today and 2023



McCulloch Lake – Dashboard – Summer



*Note the exact date of historic reservoir data is unknown. It is assumed that values represent the end of the month.

Conclusion

- Okanagan Drought – into 4th Year.
- Potable System
 - Okanagan Lake water levels at “normal”.
 - Recommend that Stage 1 water restrictions remain for users on both systems.
- Non-Potable System
 - Near normal operation.
 - Recommend that the declaration to limit users for 2024 only to their allotment else possible shutoff be rescinded.
