Our Heritage Week feature image this year is 'Sacred Spotted Lake' by Okanagan artist David Wilson. In this painting he captures the holistic nature of our heritage and connections throughout the Okanagan Valley with the sacred lake of the Okanagan People.

The work of David Wilson is an exploration of traditional narratives of the Okanagan First Nations' people. Based on pictographs found on several sites in the Okanagan region, the artist creates a reinterpretation of traditional stories.

Wilson was born and raised in the Vernon area and is a member of the Okanagan Indian Band.
