Guidelines and Bylaw

► Includes:

- Facilities owned/operated by City and or specified within a third party operating agreement

► Does not include:

- Facilities owned by City but operated by third party
- Activities and program registration fees

Amendments to Bylaw

▶ Key themes:

- ▶ Alignment with market comparisons
- ▶ Consistency
- ▶ Multi-year rate table extensions or annual 2% increase
- ▶ Introduction of new fees for bookable facilities

 - ▶ Commercial rate
 - ▶ Track and field practice rate
multi-year schedule
- ▶ Sportsfields
 - ▶ Park Permit Fee for outdoor
fitness classes



Bylaw Amendments continued

- ▶ Arenas
 - ▶ Public skating
- ▶ Multi-Purpose Facilities
- ▶ Other Facilities/Parks
 - ▶ Outdoor Events category re-classification
 - ▶ Introduction of new fees/bookable facilities
- ▶ Kelowna Community Theatre
 - ▶ 2% increase
 - ▶ CIF
