▶ Does not include:

- ► Facilities owned by City but operated by third party
- Activities and program registration fees

Amendments to Bylaw

- ► Key themes:
 - Alignment with market comparisons
 - Consistency
 - ▶ Multi-year rate table extensions or annual 2% increase
 - Introduction of new fees for bookable facilities

 - ▶ Room Rentals
- ► Aquatics lane rentals
- ► Apple Bowl
 - Commercial rate
 - Track and field practice rate multi-year schedule
- ▶ Sportsfields
 - Park Permit Fee for outdoor fitness classes





Bylaw Amendments continued

- Arenas
 - Public skating
- ► Multi-Purpose Facilities
- ▶ Other Facilities/Parks
 - Outdoor Events category re-classification
 - Introduction of new fees/bookable facilities
- ► Kelowna Community Theatre
 - ▶ 2% increase
 - ► CIF
