Staff:

Responded to guestions from Council.

- Advised that commercial assemblies, including weddings, are a restricted use within the ALC Regulations or within the City's Zoning Bylaw.

Advised that Development Cost Charges are applied to farm land during any subdivision or

building permit process.

- Noted that staff are considering using the Temporary Use Permit process as a first step in the agri-tourism process rather than rezoning to the A1(t) zone immediately.

grass cutting.

- Inquired if enforcement of snow removal and grass cutting is a priority for Bylaw Enforcement staff.

City Manager:

- Staff will need to look at the history of the number of complaints, who originated them and where they are located.

 Council is able to change the Policy, but will first need to know the budget and any other broader implications.
